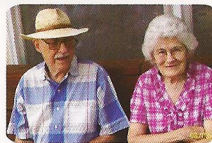

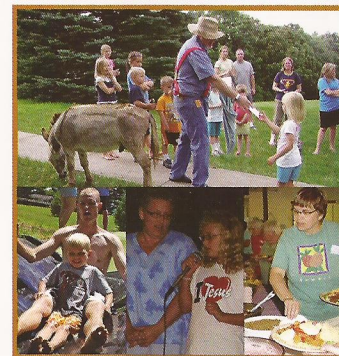

CAMP STANDARDS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Jeans and pants are acceptable attire at camp. Modest skirts, dresses and pants are recommended for dress-up occasions. No tight fitting clothing or tank tops will be permitted. Midriff tops, sagging pants and other questionable dress styles are not permitted. Swimwear: modest one-piece swimsuits for girls and boxer style for the boys. Loose fitting, knee-length shorts are permitted for all activities. Failure to abide by the spirit of these standards may result in the camper being sent home at his/her own expense.
- No youth may bring cd/mp3 players, radios, electronic games, fireworks, weapons, cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, street drugs, secular books and magazines, or clothing with questionable slogans. Youth camper cell phones and car keys need to be checked in at registration time.
- All personnel on the campgrounds are to conduct themselves as becoming a Christian (Col. 3:17, 1 Cor. 10:31) and must show proper respect to those of the opposite sex. Physical displays of affection will not be permitted.
- Attendance at all scheduled events is required. Permission to miss a session can be granted only by the Program Director.
- No youth camper may leave the camp grounds (except for organized recreational activities of the camp) without permission from the Program Director.
- All accidents or illnesses must be reported to the camp health care provider.
- At youth camps, all medications must be turned in to the camp health care provider upon arrival.
- We ask that youth campers not phone home, nor parents phone campers except in an emergency. However, letter writing is highly encouraged. Please send letters to the camper at the Whispering Cedars' address.
- All campers will be held financially responsible for abusive misuse of camp property.
- No pets allowed at youth camps. Family campers must keep their pets on a leash or in a pen.
- Visitors are welcome but are expected to abide by all camp standards.

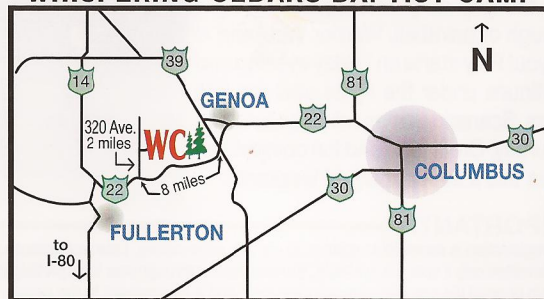
WHAT TO BRING

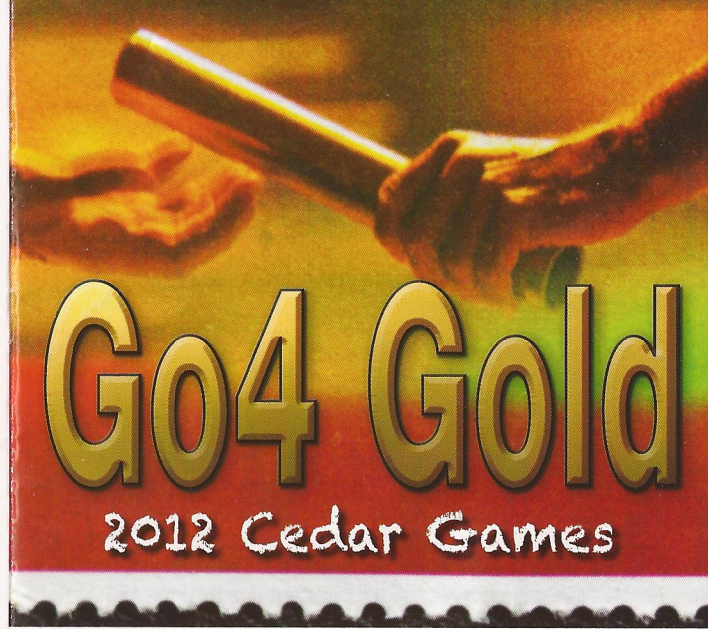

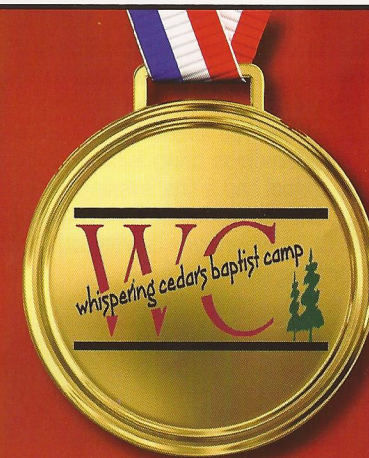
