WHO IS THE ANTI CHRIST THAT IS TO COME?

Daniel 7 “the little horn”

Revelation “the beast”

2 Thessalonians “the man of sin”

- He will be in charge of the world wide Revived Roman Empire (probably Roman; may merely be Roman-like) (Dan 7; Rev 13:3,7)
- He will be a Gentile (Rev 13:1 “beast out of the sea”)
- He will be a blasphemous ruler (Rev 13:1 “seven heads, 10 horns [Dan 7], 10 crowns, on head blasphemous names”)
- He will be mighty, but not in his own power (Dan 8:24)
- He will be empowered by Satan who will give him his throne and authority even to do miracles (Rev 13:2; 12:3, 9; 13:4, 12 “the dragon; 2Thes 2:9)
- He will use deceit to prosper in his rule (Dan 8:25; 11:36; 2Thes 2:10)
- He will prosper and thrive (Dan 8:24)
- He will move swiftly (Rev 13:2 “like a leopard”) and be powerful and destructive (“like a bear, mouth of a lion”)
- He is called the “prince to come” (Dan 9:26)
- He will have great intelligence and insight (Dan 7:8 20, 25 “full of eyes”)
- He will understand sinister schemes (Dan 8:23)
- He will “think to change the times and laws” (Dan 7:25)
- He will be a “man of lawlessness” (2Thes 2:3)
- He will be cunning (Dan 8:25)
- He will be proud (Dan 8:25)
- He will have no desire of women (Dan 11:37 – either have interests in women or women’s interests NIV).
- He will be mortally wounded and miraculously healed so that the whole world will follow him (Rev 13:3; 2Thes 2:11)

- He will exalt and magnify himself above every god (Dan 11:36, 37; 2Thes 2:4)
- He will have no regard for the god/God of his fathers (Dan 11:27)
- He will speak blasphemous things against God (Dan 11:36; Rev 13:5-6)
- He will stop the sacrifices and offerings to God (Dan 9:27)
- He will “he will set up an abomination that causes desolation” NIV (Dan 9:27)
- He will proclaim himself to be god (2Thes 2:4)
- He will be worshiped by everyone except “the elect” (Rev 13:4, 8)
- He will be the vehicle by which the world worships Satan (Rev 13:4 either directly or indirectly)

- He will have a god of fortress (prob. military might), a god which his fathers did not know (Dan 11:38)
- He will honor that god with gold, silver, precious stones, and pleasant things (Dan 11:38)
- He will do according to his will (Dan 11:36)
- He will bring great destruction (Dan 8:24 “destroy fearfully” נִכְרַם)
- He will make a seven year treaty with Israel and break it half way through (Dan 9:27)
- His will have his most prominent activity will last 3 ½ years (Dan 7:25 “time, times [dual], and half a time”; Rev 13:5))
- He will destroy the Jews (Dan 8:24 “holy people”)
- He will divide the land (Israel?) for gain (Dan 11:39)
- He will destroy Jerusalem and its Temple (Dan 9:26 “the city and sanctuary”)
- He will destroy the mighty (Dan 8:24)
- He will destroy many in their prosperity (Dan 8:25)
- He will make the saints suffer (Dan 7:21, 25; Rev 13:7)
- He will raise against the Jesus (Dan 8:25 “Prince of princes)
- He will be doomed to destruction (2Thes 2:3)
- He will not be broken by human means (Dan 8:25)
- He will be destroyed by Jesus directly (2Thes 2:8; Rev 20:15)
